General Introduction

Daubeney is a purpose built middle school, with a four form entry. It takes pupils aged 9-13 years of mixed ability and is fully inclusive. There are a wide variety of different cultural groups which are celebrated within the school.

Daubeney has a strong reputation within the community for its stable and well established team of teaching and non-teaching staff. At present the school is over subscribed.

A strong emphasis is placed on pastoral care within the curriculum to support children and ensure continuity and progression. Children in need of more specialised help are identified early on to ensure that they have the support to fully access the curriculum and fulfill their potential.

Since September 2008 Daubeney has been part of the Kempston Education Trust.
