The Governing Body meets regularly to review and discuss all aspects of the life of the school. The Governor's role is defined as taking a strategic view, acting as a critical friend and ensuring accountability.

Governors are elected by parents and the teaching staff, others are nominated by the Local Authority and the remaining members are appointed by the Governing Body to represent the interests of the community and the Kempston Education Trust.
